I would also appreciate any available catalogue information, including its current location, accession or collection record, and whether a reference photograph or reproduction is available for research purposes.

I am also hoping to locate contemporary material about Dorothy Chapman herself, particularly:

- the 1980 Carmel Pine Cone interview/profile conducted at her San Antonio Street home;
- the 9 April 1964 Monterey Peninsula Herald article, "Mrs. Chapman Works to Preserve Carmel"; and
- any Carmel Cultural Commission minutes, clippings, photographs, or other local-history materials connected to her.

Could you let me know which of these materials the Library holds, whether they can be viewed in person or remotely, and whether an appointment is needed?
